## BOSTON MUST-DO EXPERIENCES

- 1. The Freedom Trail**  
Follow this 2.5-mile path to 16 historic sites that tell the story of America's fight for independence.
- 2. Boston Common and Public Gardens (Freedom Trail)**  
Relax in America's oldest public park and stroll the beautiful, Victorian-era Public Gardens next door.
- 3. Swan Boats of Boston (Freedom Trail)**  
Enjoy a classic ride on a swan-shaped boat in the Public Garden lagoon (seasonal).
- 4. Make Way for the Ducklings Statue**  
See the beloved bronze statues inspired by the classic children's book by Robert McCloskey.
- 5. New England Aquarium**  
Explore thousands of marine animals and the famous Giant Ocean Tank.
- 6. Faneuil Hall Marketplace and Quincy Market (Freedom Trail)**  
Shop, dine and soak up history at this lively marketplace by the waterfront.
- 7. The Bull and Finch (The Original Cheers Bar)**  
Step inside the real Cheers bar that inspired the hit TV show.
- 8. Boston Red Sox Fenway Park Tour**  
Go behind the scenes of America's oldest ballpark—Fenway Park.
- 9. Boston Massacre Site (Freedom Trail)**  
Visit the site of the 1770 confrontation that helped spark the American Revolution.
- 10. Samuel Adams Brewery Tour**  
Learn about Boston's brewing heritage and enjoy a tasting.
- 11. Massachusetts State House (Freedom Trail)**  
Tour this stunning building with its iconic gold dome.
- 12. Old State House Museum (Freedom Trail)**  
Discover Boston's colonial history in the oldest public building in the city.
- 13. Boston Duck Tour**  
A fun, amphibious tour of Boston by land and water.
- 14. Paul Revere House (Freedom Trail)**  
Visit Paul Revere's 1680s home and learn about his famous midnight ride.
- 15. The Harvard University Tour**  
Walk through historic Harvard Yard and explore one of the world's top universities.

- 16. Old South Meeting House**  
A historic meeting place of the American Revolution.
- 17. Old North Church**  
See the lanterns that signaled Paul Revere's famous ride.
- 18. Bunker Hill Monument**  
Climb the monument and learn about the Battle of Bunker Hill.
- 19. Harpoon Brewery Tour and Beer Hall**  
Enjoy a behind-the-scenes tour and craft beers by the waterfront.
- 20. Granary Burying Ground**  
One of Boston's oldest cemeteries, final resting place of many revolutionary figures.
- 21. Boston Teaparty Ships and Museum**  
Step aboard replica ships and relive the Boston Tea Party.
- 22. JFK Presidential Library and Museum**  
Explore the life, legacy and leadership of President John F. Kennedy.
- 23. USS Constitution**  
Tour "Old Ironsides," the world's oldest commissioned warship afloat.
- 24. Charles River Sightseeing Tour**  
See Boston's skyline and landmarks from the water.
- 25. Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum**  
Home to an incredible art collection in a Venetian-style palace.

- 2. MIT Museum**  
Explore fascinating exhibits on science, technology and innovation.
