-  **1. Eiffel Tower**

-  **2. Arc de Triomphe**  
A grand monument honoring those who fought for France. Climb to the top for stunning views.
-  **3. Champs-Élysées**  
The world's most famous avenue for shopping, cafés and people watching.
-  **4. Sacré-Cœur Basilica**  
A beautiful white basilica with amazing views over Paris from Montmartre.
-  **5. Bateaux Parisiens Siene Cruise**  
Relax on a scenic river cruise and see the best of Paris from the Seine.
-  **6. Notre-Dame Cathedral**  
A masterpiece of Gothic architecture and a symbol of Paris.
-  **7. Louvre Museum**  
Home to thousands of works of art, including the Mona Lisa and Venus de Milo.
-  **8. Musée de l'Ordre de la Libération**  
A moving museum dedicated to France's WWII heroes and the Free French.
-  **9. Sainte-Chapelle**  
Famous for its stunning stained glass windows and Gothic beauty.
-  **10. Moulin Rouge**  
The world-famous cabaret for an unforgettable evening in Paris.
-  **11. Grevin Museum**  
Meet lifelike wax figures of celebrities, historical icons and more.
-  **12. La Concierge**  
A historic prison and part of the Conciergerie, rich in Revolutionary history.
-  **13. Big Bus Paris Hop-On Hop-Off Tour**  
See Paris at your own pace with flexible stops at top attractions.
-  **14. Petit Train de Montmartre**  
A charming mini-train ride through the streets of Montmartre.
-  **15. Tour Montparnasse**  
Paris' skyscraper offering panoramic views of the city, including the Eiffel Tower.

-  **16. Stade de France Tour**  
Go behind the scenes of France's national stadium and walk in the footsteps of champions.
-  **17. Pantheon**  
A neoclassical monument honoring France's greatest thinkers and leaders.
-  **18. Dali Paris**  
Explore the surreal world of Salvador Dali in this unique museum.
-  **19. Chapelle Expiatoire**  
A peaceful chapel built in memory of King Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette.

A vibrant artists' squat and gallery space full of creativity.

Home to Monet's magnificent Water Lilies and more.
