Best Free Attractions in Paris, France



1 Enjoy the Eiffel Tower 

See Paris' most iconic landmark from many beautiful spots around the city—by day or at night when it sparkles every hour.

2 Visit the Place du Trocadéro 

The best viewpoint for postcard-perfect photos of the Eiffel Tower and the Seine, plus lovely gardens and fountains.

3 Stroll Down the Champs-Élysées 

Wander the world's most beautiful avenue between Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe. Perfect for people watching.

4 Check out the Arc de Triomphe 


Marvel at this grand monument and its intricate detailing, with the famous roundabout and tomb of the Unknown Soldier below.

5 Pose at the Louvre Museum 

Snap photos at the iconic glass pyramid and admire the stunning palace façade—no ticket needed to enjoy the exterior.

6 Wander Up to the Sacré Coeur 

Visit this beautiful white basilica for free and enjoy breathtaking views over Paris from Montmartre hill.

7 Walk Along the River Seine 

Stroll beside the Seine and take in famous sights, charming bridges and the true Parisian atmosphere.

8 Gaze at Notre Dame 

Admire the stunning Gothic architecture of this historic cathedral from the outside as it stands on the Île de la Cité.

9 Visit Celebrities at Cimetière du Père-Lachaise 

Explore this peaceful cemetery and see the final resting places of icons like Jim Morrison, Edith Piaf and Oscar Wilde.

10 Experience the Cabaret of the Moulin Rouge 

Admire the famous red windmill and vibrant façade of this legendary cabaret in the heart of Montmartre.

11 Visit a Museum for Free 

On the first Sunday of every month, many of Paris' top museums open their doors for free—including the Louvre and Musée d'Orsay.

12 Take a Look at the Statue of Liberty – Pont de Grenelle 

See this quarter-scale replica on the Île aux Cygnes in the Seine—a gift from the U.S. to France.

13 Saunter Through the Latin Quarter 

Explore charming streets, historic sites and lively cafés in one of Paris' most characterful neighbourhoods.

14 Get Inspired at 59 Rivoli Art Gallery 

Visit this unique artists' collective and gallery near the Louvre—free entry, exhibitions and creative vibes.

15 Picnic in the Tuileries Garden 

Relax in this beautiful historic garden between the Louvre and Place de la Concorde—perfect for a picnic and a break.

16 Roam Around the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris 

Enjoy free modern art from Matisse, Picasso and more in this excellent museum near the Eiffel Tower.

17 Reflect at the Fontaine Saint-Michel 

Admire this dramatic neo-Renaissance fountain featuring Archangel Michael and impressive sculptures.

18 Learn on a Free Walking Tour 

Discover Paris' history and stories on a tip-based walking tour—just search, book ahead and enjoy!
