THINGS TO DO IN SKAGEN DENMARK



• YOUR ULTIMATE SKAGEN CHECKLIST •

- 1 Walk Around Skagen Town Centre** 

Wander the charming town centre, enjoy the shops, cafés and restaurants, admire the yellow houses and relax by the scenic harbour front.
- 2 Grenen – The Meeting of Two Seas** 

Stand where the North Sea meets the Baltic Sea at Grenen. Reach it by car, bus, bike or a scenic walk and enjoy this unforgettable natural wonder.
- 3 Råbjerg Mile Dunes** 

Explore Northern Europe's largest moving sand dune. Climb the sandy hills, enjoy stunning views and feel like you're in a desert by the sea.
- 4 Skagens Museum** 

Discover 19th–20th century art by Skagen painters like Krøyer and the Anchers, plus special exhibitions and a lovely café.
- 5 Anchers Hus** 

Visit the preserved home and studio of Anna and Michael Ancher on Markvej. See their life as it was in the 19th century and view fine European art.
- 6 Drachmanns Hus** 

Explore the former home of author and painter Holger Drachmann, kept as it was from 1902–1908, with around 150 of his works on display.
- 7 The Sand-Covered Church** 

Visit the 14th-century church tower partially buried by sand in the 1700s. Climb the tower for views and a glimpse of nature's impact on history.
- 8 Skagen Graa Fyr (Grey Lighthouse)** 

Climb 208 steps in this active lighthouse & bird observatory. Enjoy panoramic views and an exhibition on migrating birds.
- 9 The Bunker Museum** 

Explore a WWII German bunker at Grenen with artifacts, uniforms, weapons, a film room and an operations room.
- 10 Brøndums Hotel** 

A historic hotel and restaurant where artists gathered. Linked to the Anchers and famous guests like Hans Christian Andersen and Karen Blixen.
- 11 Skagen Kirke – Skagen Church** 

A beautiful white church built in 1841 with boats hanging from the ceiling and flowers on the pews. Open daily (10am–6pm).
- 12 Skagen Water Tower** 

Built in 1934 with 130,000 bricks and 34m tall. Climb 120 steps to the top for lovely views over Skagen.
- 13 Mindestotten Memorial** 

A stone memorial near the water tower honouring eight fishermen who died during a rescue mission in 1862.
- 14 Skagens Bamsemuseum** 

A delightful teddy bear museum with bears from around the world and displays on their history. Perfect for families!
- 15 Kystmuseet** 

A small museum showing life in Skagen during the 19th century, with a focus on the fishing industry and local history.
- 16 Walk the Harbour Front** 

Enjoy picturesque views, fresh sea air and great places to eat and drink along the harbour.
- 17 Visit Local Art Galleries** 

Explore Skagen's many galleries featuring local and contemporary Danish art.
- 18 Enjoy Skagen's Beaches** 

Relax on beautiful sandy beaches and enjoy the fresh North Sea air.
- 19 Go Bird Watching** 

Skagen is a top spot for birdwatching, especially in spring and autumn.
- 20 Sunset at Grenen** 

End the day at Grenen with stunning sunsets where two seas meet – a truly magical experience.
