THINGS TO DO IN NAPLES, ITALY



1. NAPLES NATIONAL ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

Home to one of the world's finest collections of Greco-Roman artefacts, including treasures from Pompeii and Herculaneum.



2. CHURCH OF SANTA CHIARA AND THE MAJOLICA CLOISTER

A stunning Gothic church and peaceful cloister famous for its beautiful hand-painted majolica tiles.



3. VIA SAN GREGORIO ARMENO

The famous 'Street of the Nativity Scene', lined with artisan workshops selling handmade figurines and Christmas decorations all year round.



4. GESÙ NUOVO

A striking church with a unique diamond-shaped façade and a rich history in the heart of Naples.



5. PIO MONTE DELLA MISERICORDIA

Home to Caravaggio's masterpiece 'The Seven Works of Mercy' in an important Neapolitan confraternity.



6. CAPPELLA SANSEVERO

Famous for the Veiled Christ sculpture and other incredible works of art and mysterious symbolism.



7. LUNGOMARE

Enjoy a scenic stroll along the seafront promenade with breathtaking views of the Bay of Naples and Vesuvius.



8. ROYAL PALACE OF NAPLES

The grandeur of monarchy in Naples, featuring opulent rooms, historic furniture and beautiful views.



9. NAPLES CATHEDRAL

The city's Duomo, home to the relic of Saint Gennaro and beautiful chapels and artwork.



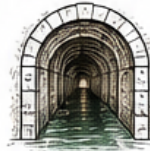
10. FONTANELLE CEMETERY

A unique underground ossuary with thousands of skulls and a deep spiritual significance for locals.



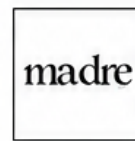
11. CASTEL SANT'ELMO

14. SAN CARLO THEATRE

One of the world's oldest and most prestigious opera houses, rich in history and elegance.



15. CASTEL NUOVO (NEW CASTLE)

An iconic medieval castle with impressive towers, museums and historical significance.
