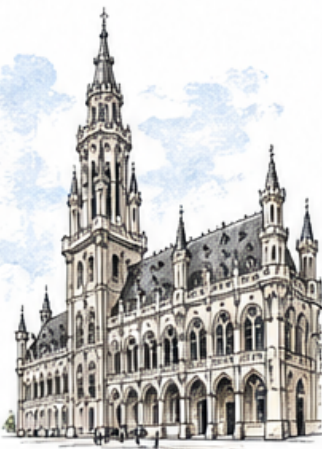
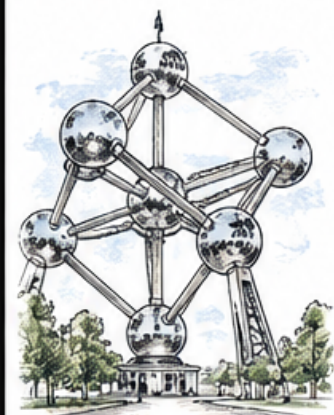

### TOP THINGS TO DO IN BRUSSELS

- Manneken Pis – Peeing Boy** – Iconic bronze statue and a symbol of Brussels' playful spirit.
- Grand Place – Central Plaza** – Stunning UNESCO-listed square surrounded by ornate guildhalls.
- Atomium** – Futuristic landmark built for Expo 58 with panoramic city views.
- Cathedral of St. Michael and St. Gudula** – Impressive Gothic cathedral in the heart of the city.
- Mont des Arts – Mount of the Arts** – Scenic cultural hub with gardens and great views.
- Galleries Royales Saint-Hubert** – Elegant 19th-century shopping arcades.
- Musical Instrument Museum** – Fascinating collection of instruments from around the world.
- Bubble Planet Experience** – Immersive interactive journey through a bubble wonderland.
- Jeanneke Pis – Peeing Girl** – Quirky bronze statue and counterpart to Manneken Pis.
- Everard t'Serclaes Bronze Monument** – A local legend said to bring good luck.
- Zinneke Pis** – Fun statue of a peeing dog celebrating Brussels' free spirit.
- Comic Book Trail** – Follow colorful murals honoring Belgium's comic book heroes.
- Commemoration of Peter the Great's Vomit** – A quirky plaque marking a peculiar piece of history.
- Petit Sablon Neighbourhood** – Charming area known for antiques, galleries and chocolate shops.
- Black Tower in Brussels** – Remnant of the medieval city walls with a fascinating past.
- Birthplace of Audrey Hepburn** – Visit the house where the legendary actress was born.
- The Royal Palace of Brussels** – Official palace of the Belgian royal family (open in summer).
- Mini Europe Park** – See Europe's most famous landmarks in miniature.

- Parc du Cinquantenaire** – Grand park with monumental arches and museums.
- Planetarium of Brussels** – Explore the stars in Belgium's largest planetarium.

- Jeu de Balle Flea Market** – Lively outdoor market with antiques and vintage finds.
- Museum of Brussels** – Discover the city's history and heritage.
- Museum of Illusions** – Mind-bending exhibits that defy reality.
- Museum of Natural Sciences** – Dinosaurs, gems, minerals and more.
- Royal Museum of Fine Arts of Belgium** – Masterpieces from the 15th century to today.
- Train World** – Belgium's railway history brought to life.
- Royal Museum of the Armed Forces and of Military History** – Military exhibits spanning centuries.
- Brussels Comics Figurines Museum** – Thousands of figurines from your favorite comics.
