THINGS TO DO IN MODENA ITALY

- 1. Casa Museo Luciano Pavarotti**

The former home of the legendary tenor. Explore 12 rooms over 4 floors filled with personal treasures, memorabilia and insight into his extraordinary life and career.
- 2. Piazza Grande**

The heart of Modena and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Admire stunning Romanesque architecture, cafés, the Pietra Ringadora and La Bonissima statue.
- 3. Modena Cathedral (Duomo di Modena)**

A magnificent Romanesque cathedral consecrated in 1184. Entrance is free and the interior features beautiful sculptures, reliefs and historic artwork.
- 4. Ghirlandina Bell Tower**

Modena's iconic 86-metre bell tower beside the Duomo. Climb around 200 steps for incredible views of the city. Entry fee applies.
- 5. Ferrari Museum in Maranello**

Dedicated to Scuderia Ferrari, racing history and iconic cars. Near the factory with driving experiences and more. Entry fee applies.
- 6. Enzo Ferrari Museum**

Birthplace of Enzo Ferrari with his restored home and an exhibition of vintage cars and memorabilia. Entry fee applies.
- 7. Teatro Comunale Luciano Pavarotti & Monument**

Modena's theatre named after Pavarotti. See the statue of the maestro outside the building.
- 8. Palazzo Ducale (Ducal Palace)**

Historic palace of the Este family. Interior tours available on weekends (fee applies). Now home to the Military Academy, Museum and Library.
- 9. Novi Ark Archeologico Park (Parco Novi Sad)**

Free open-air Roman ruins from the ancient city of Mutina including roads, tombs and buildings. Information panels explain the history.

- 10. Pietra Ringadora**

Ancient red marble stone once used for speeches, announcements and even executions during medieval times.
- 11. Mercato Albinelli**

Historic indoor market with art Nouveau beauty. Fresh local food, shops and restaurants. Open Mon–Sat.
- 12. Via Farini**

Charming street near the palace with shops, cafés and the historic Giusti food shop (est. 1605). Perfect for a stroll.
- 13. Church of Saint Augustine**

Important church and Este family pantheon with beautiful art and sculptures. Free entry.

ADDITIONAL ATTRACTIONS IN MODENA

- **Lamborghini Automobile Museum** – 30 min from Modena. History of Lamborghini with models and factory tour. €18 (May 2025). Open daily 9:30am–7pm.
- **Madonne Caseificio dell'Emilia** – Parmigiano Reggiano cheese factory tour with tasting. €20 for 1 hour. Open daily 8:30am–7:30pm (Sun 9am–1pm).
- **Acetaia Giusti** – See how traditional balsamic vinegar is made. Free tour with tasting. Open daily 9am–6pm.
- **Panini Motor Museum** – Collection of Maserati cars and vintage motorcycles. Free entry. Mon–Fri 9am–12:30pm & 3pm–6pm, Sat 9am–12:30pm.
- **Galleria Estense** – Art gallery with works from the d'Este collection. €8. Closed Mon. Tue–Sat 8:30am–7:30pm, Sun 10am–6pm.
- **Museo della Figurine** – Museum of collectible cards. €6. Closed Mon & Tue. Wed–Sun 3pm–7pm.
- **Palazzo dei Musei** – Museum of art, archaeology, history & civics. €8. Closed Sun & Mon. Tue–Sat 8:30am–7:30pm.
- **Modena Civic Museum** – Impressive local art and sculpture collection. Free entry. Hours vary – check online before you go.
